Energy markets saw mixed signals as geopolitical tensions in the Middle East continued to influence crude oil prices, which eased after earlier gains. Natural gas prices dropped to a six-week low amid maintenance at a major LNG export facility. Meanwhile, shipping rates, particularly for VLGCs and tankers, remained robust, driven by ongoing supply chain adjustments and strong demand.
